## What is the Maine Beef Producers Association?

The MBPA is a producer group with members throughout the state.

Our goal is to maintain a viable beef cattle industry through producer education, cooperative marketing and development and support of youth programs.







- FEEDER CALF and BREEDING STOCK SALES The cooperative marketing and organization of feeder calf sales that was started in 1988 has improved the bottom line of all producers in Maine. Preconditioning requirements were established by MBPA to further enhance the quality of animals offered for sale. Although private sales by farms directly to buyers has made the feeder auctions not necessary, our website allows members to list their animals for sale to the general public.
- CLUB CALF SHOW & SALE This event provides an opportunity for youth to evaluate and purchase a 4-H project animal from a variety of calves at the Fryeberg Fair.
- CALVES 4 KIDS PROGRAM This program places heifer calves with youth who will return their first female calf to the program. This is educational program for youth andgives hands on experience in raising a heifer through calving.
- SCHOLARSHIPS Awards are available to MBPA beef farm family members or employee for higher education.

- EDUCATIONAL EVENTS The MBPA events
- include the Cattlemen's College, Northeast Livestock Expo, and workshops at the Agricultural Trades Show. We work with the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Services to educate producers.
